14th February: Ash Wednesday - the beginning of Lent.

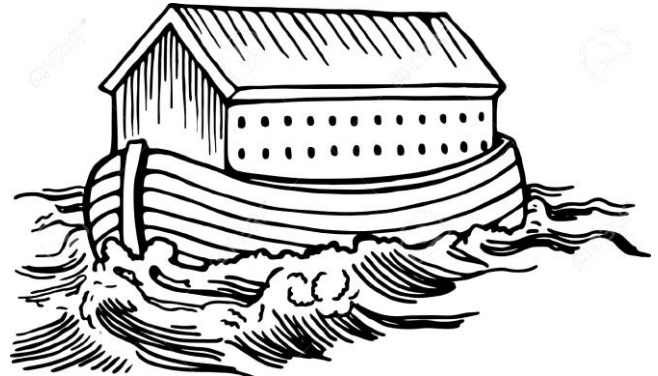
24th March: Palm Sunday

This term we will be learning all about Judaism.



To the Promised Land

During this topic the children will learn about the book of Exodus in the Old Testament. They will learn the stories of key people in the history of God such as Noah and Moses and will learn to describe the promises that they each made with God. Pupils will be able to retell the story of Moses life and describe how he was chosen by God to do a very important job.

From Lent to Easter



During this topic the class will learn about the Stations of the Cross and their importance during Lent. Children will also learn to retell the stories of Palm Sunday, The Last supper and Jesus's betrayal. They will be encouraged to think of ways that they can become closer to God during the important time of Lent through the practices of Almsgiving, Fasting and Prayer.
