This term your child will be looking at two religious education themes, they are:

- From Ur to the Promised Land
- Lent to Easter

Each topic will last for a half term.



From Lent to Easter

During this topic the class will learn about the Stations of the Cross, Jesus' entry into Jerusalem, the Last Supper and His betrayal as told in the Gospel of Mark. Children will discuss how these events have had an impact on the lives of believers today and how they have shaped the Catholic faith. Pupils will also demonstrate an understanding of the signs and symbols linked to the feast of the Epiphany and reflect on why it is an important day for believers across the world.



From Ur to the Promised Land

During this unit, pupils will learn about the book of Exodus in the Old Testament. They will focus on the call of Moses in the story of the Burning Bush and the covenant that was made between God and Moses. Pupils will learn to use specialist religious vocabulary to explain what a covenant is and they will understand that several covenants were made between God and key people in the Old Testament such as Noah, Moses and Abraham.
