**RECOGNITION AND ACCEPTANCE OF THE SCHOOL'S CATHOLIC RELIGIOUS ETHOS.**

1. Blessed Dominic Catholic School has been founded to provide for the educational needs of Catholic families in this part of the Diocese of Westminster.
