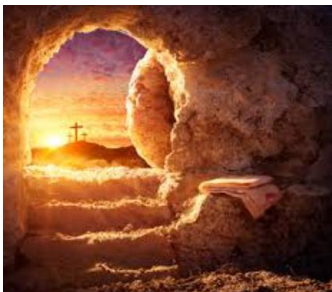
This term your child will be studying two different topics in Religious Education:

- To the Ends of the Earth
- Dialogue and Encounter

Each topic will last approximately six weeks.

To the Ends of the Earth

In this unit, children will explore the events of Jesus' resurrection, they will learn why Christians believe Jesus rose from the dead and why this is a central part of their faith. Pupils will understand how the disciples came to believe in the resurrection through their experiences of seeing and speaking with Jesus, and how this belief continues to shape Christian life today. They will also learn about the idea of standing up for one's beliefs, including the example of people who showed great courage in their faith. Pupils will also learn about inspiring individuals and organisations who work to support people facing hardship or injustice around the world.

Dialogue and Encounter

In this unit, children will learn about the importance of unity, respect, and working together for the good of all people. They will explore how Christians are called to care for others and contribute positively to their communities. Pupils will be introduced to the idea of a "worldview" and begin to understand how different people see and understand the world in different ways. Children will also learn about practical ways people can work together to achieve shared goals and make a difference. As part of their learning, they will explore beliefs and ways of life from the Hindu faith helping them to recognise similarities and differences between faiths
