Autumn Term 2026

This term your child will be studying two different topics in Religious Education:

- Creation and Covenant
- Prophecy and Promise

Each topic will last approximately six weeks.

Creation and Covenant

Throughout this topic, the pupils will be learning the story of Noah and the Covenant that he made with God. They will be reflecting on the meaning of special symbols in the story such as the dove and the rainbow. Pupils will also reflect on the beauty of creation and learn about stewardship, thinking about ways in which that they care for creation.



Catholic Social Teaching

Our Catholic Social Teaching topics will be:

Autumn 1: Care of Creation

Autumn 2: Preference for the poor

Prophecy and Promise

During this unit, pupils will be learning the story of the Annunciation, and the births of John the Baptist and Jesus as told in the Gospel of Luke. They will also learn to describe ways in which Christians prepare for the coming of Jesus at Christmas during the Advent Season. Pupils will learn about the symbol of the Advent Wreath and be learning to pray the Magnificat, a special prayer which was sung by Mary when she discovered that she was going to be the mother of Jesus.

22nd November: The feast of Christ the King

29th December: The First Sunday in Advent
