Autumn Term 2026

This term your child will be studying two different topics in Religious Education:

- Creation and Covenant
- Prophecy and Promise

Each topic will last approximately six weeks.

Creation and Covenant

In this unit, pupils will study the first story of creation as told in Genesis. They will reflect on the belief that we are made in the image and likeness of God and reflect upon how we can treat others with dignity. Throughout this unit they will develop their use of religious vocabulary and begin to use it to describe different prayers such as the Psalms which praise God's creation. Pupils will also be reflection on how they can be stewards of God's creation and look after our world.



Catholic Social Teaching

Our Catholic Social Teaching topics will be:

Autumn 1: Care of Creation

Autumn 2: Preference for the poor

Prophecy and Promise

In this topic, children will focus on the structure of the Mass. They will learn to describe each part of the Mass and gain an understanding into the different signs, symbols and prayers that are used. Pupils will also learn about Joseph and how he showed great faith in God when an angel appeared to him. Pupils will also begin to make simple links between the signs used in Advent and Christmas and their meaning for Christians.

22nd November: The feast of Christ the King

29th December: The First Sunday in Advent
