Autumn Term 2026

This term your child will be studying two different topics in Religious Education:

- Creation and Covenant
- Prophecy and Promise

Each topic will last approximately six weeks.

Creation and Covenant

Throughout this academic year your child will learn about the Gospel of John. As our first topic is focused on the Old Testament and the creation accounts, pupils will look at the second account of Creation, understanding what is meant by the 'Fall' and be able to make connections with Jesus as the new Adam in St John's gospel. The pupils will also gain an understanding into the Nicene Creed and reflect upon what it teaches us about God the creator.



Catholic Social Teaching

Our Catholic Social Teaching topics this term will be:

Autumn 1: Care of Creation

Autumn 2: Preference for the poor

Prophecy and Promise

In this unit, pupils will be exploring some of the stories about prominent women in the Old Testament such as Miriam, Judith and Esther. They will also learn about the historical and social context in which these stories took place. There will be a particular focus on Mary, how she is represented in St John's Gospel and her role in the history of the Catholic Faith.
